Financial: This is a 1,700-hour AmeriCorps Position, with a bi-weekly stipend of \$845.

Benefits: After successfully completing your AmeriCorps term of service and enrolling in the National Service Trust, participants are eligible to receive the Segal AmeriCorps Education Award of \$6,985. This award may be used to repay qualified student loans and to pay current educational expenses at eligible institutions of higher education and training programs. This award can be transferred to children and grandchildren.
