## PINE GROVE FURNACE STATE PARK

### BEST FAMILY-FRIENDLY HIKE

The Appalachian Trail and Hiker Biker Trail from the Furnace Area past Fuller Lake. It's one mile long and all flat so takes about 20 minutes.

### **HIDDEN GEM**

Mountain Creek, anywhere as it runs two miles between Fuller Lake and Laurel Lake.



#### **BEST VIEW**

A rocky overlook a few steps off Koppenhaver Trail overlooking Toms Run as it enters Mountain Creek. (40.02988, -77.29530)

#### **BEST EATS**

Get great burgers, wraps, fries, and ice cream at the General Store near the Furnace.

## MOST CHALLENGING HIKE

The Koppenhaver/Mountain
Creek trail can be made
more difficult by continuing
to the neighboring Michaux
State Forest's Pole Steeple
Trail, a steep but rewarding
3/4-mile climb.

## FAVORITE MEDIUM INTENSITY TRAIL

The Koppenhaver Trail onto
Mountain Creek Trail is a two-mile
(one-way) hike. No bikes are
allowed! Takes about an hour, and
you get to see some wonderful
bridges funded and installed by the
Friends!
